




"No man of another nation to enter within the fence and enclosure round the temple. And whoever is caught will have himself to blame that his death ensues."




"When you go through these [first] cloisters, unto the second [court of the] temple, <u>there was a</u> <u>partition made of stone all round</u>, whose height was three cubits: its construction was very elegant; upon it stood pillars, at equal distance from one another, <u>declaring the law of purity</u>, <u>some in Greek</u>, and <u>some in Roman letters</u>, that <u>'no foreigner should go within that sanctuary</u>;' for that second [court of the] temple was called 'the Sanctuary;' and was ascended to by fourteen steps from the first court."



























Ephesians 2:14-15
